

Newly Seeded Lawns

Irrigation:

- The new lawn area must not dry out
- Gently water once each day for at least three weeks
- Early morning is the most beneficial time to water
- When grass is 4" high, watering may be cut back
- Deep watering during drought period is very important

Mowing:

- Mow only when the grass is at least 4" high
- Mower blade should be sharp
- Set mower height to at least 3" and higher in mid summer
- Cut no more than 1/3 of the grass blade at one mowing

Fertilizing:

- Your lawn was fertilized when we did the initial work
- All of the lawn areas should be fertilized three times per year
- Use a quality natural fertilizer for best and safest results

Weeds and Chemicals:

Lawn weeds are unavoidable, but can be kept under control Healthy grass is the best natural weed control Keep your lawn healthy by:

- Maintaining proper turf height
- Fertilize appropriately
- Soil test and apply lime as recommended
- Top dress with organic material
- Irrigate when rainfall is insufficient
- Aerate each fall
- Remove thatch buildup

• Weeding by hand is the safest means of weed removal, however if you choose to use chemicals, wait until the lawn has been cut at least three times.
